First Visit With Referral

Please go to the "Patient Support Center" (Counter 17).





First Visit Without Referral

Please go to the "Main Reception" (Counter 1).



Return Visit By appointment

On your return visit with an appointment, go to the above machines (Area 10) right after you walk in the main entrance. Insert your registration card, take the slip and your registration for the day is complete.

After the reception, you will have a secondary reception (Reception A, B, C, or D) depending on the department.

How to Request Care at Kikan Hospital

- ♣ Appointments can be made through other medical institutions. You can also make an appointment at "Patient Support Center" (Counter 17) if you bring a referral.
- → Depending on the departments or your medical condition, you could visit Kikan Hospital without an appointment or a referral. However, you will be charged with a special health-care fee of 7,700 yen (for medical departments) or 5,500 yen (for dental departments) and a long waiting time is expected. You should have a referral from other hospitals/clinics such as Yukiguni Yamato Hospital, Moegi Clinic.

Steps in Receiving Care at Kikan Hospital

First Visit With Referral

Go to "Patient Support Center" (Counter 17). The staff will receive your referral. Please fill in an application form, and you will receive a reception sheet for the day, your patient registration card (if this is your first visit), as well as a yellow file.

First Visit Without Referral/ Appointment

Go to "Reception" (Counter 1) to fill in an application form, and you will receive a reception sheet for the day, your patient registration card (if this is your first visit), as well as yellow file.

Return Visit By appointment

If this is a return visit with an appointment, please insert your patient registration card into the "Revisiting Patients Reception" machine, and you will receive a reception slip.

Go to Reception A, B, C, or D (A&B on the 1st floor, C&D on the 2nd floor)

≪First time visitors≫

Submit your yellow file. Fill out a questionnaire and wait in the waiting area.

≪Returning visitors≫

Submit your reception slip, and present your NHI card. You will receive a yellow file. Wait in the waiting area.

Wait at the corridor around the block reception or in the inner hall. When it is your turn to see the doctor, the number on your reception sheet will be displayed on the TV monitor.

Doctor Consultation

After you see the doctor, the Doctor or Nurse will give you a yellow file. Please submit it to Reception A,B,C,D, or Counter 5 for fee calculation.

Cashier

Make your payment at the cashier (Counter 6) or at the automatic payment machine (Counter 7).

Who falls into the Category of "First Visitor"?

- 1) Those who visit Kikan Hospital for the very first time.
- 2) Those who visit a new department within Kikan Hospital.

Example: You have been to the hospital but you are seeing a different department than you used before.

3) Those who visit Kikan Hospital for the first time after a while.

Clarification: Those who go back to the same department, but for a new condition, or reoccurring condition after once recovering from it.

Example: You have completed your treatment for a cold back in December, but get a second cold in March and need to start medication again.

What is a Referral?

"Referral" means a letter of introduction from a doctor at another medical facility; hospital or clinic.

ER – Emergency Room

Please note that you can visit the ER only if you are in urgent need of care and/or critically ill. It means, you can visit the ER outside of our business hours (weekend or holiday) for true emergencies or in case the ambulance crew brings you to the Kikan ER. If coming on your own, you are required to contact us by phone (025-777-3200) before coming. Through making triage in the ER, the emergency team decides the order to see the patients.

♣ Japanese medical treatment, options and medication may differ from what you
